A number of items have been excluded such as milestones, walls, gate piers, telephone kiosks.

A characteristic of the Yorkshire Dales is the many free-standing substantial barns, often some distance away from the farmhouse to which they belong. This township, which was in Yorkshire West Riding until the 1974 Local Government Reorganisation, has 7 such barns, apart from those which are attached to their farmhouses. As such a feature, they have been included here. [In the case of the Cumberland and Westmoreland barns, there are only a few cases (or few are listed) and the general policy there has been to omit them.]
