A number of items have been excluded such as milestones, walls, gate piers, telephone kiosks.

Listed buildings in Sedbergh

A characteristic of the Yorkshire Dales is the many free-standing substantial barns, often some distance away from the farmhouse to which they belong. This township, which was in Yorkshire West Riding until the 1974 Local Government Reorganisation, has 16 such barns, apart from those which are attached to their farmhouses. As such a feature, they have been included here. [In the case of the Cumberland and Westmoreland barns, there are only a few cases (or few are listed) and the general policy there has been to omit them.]
