Askerton	1861 - Decline in population is attributed to emigration and the removal of agricultural labourers to other districts. 1901 - Askerton was previously constituted a township of Lanercost Parish. It became a Civil Parish in 1894 1981 - 137 persons usually resident. 1991 - 165 persons usually resident.
Bailey	1841 - Decline in population due to removal of 34 female servants to other parts.
Banks	1801 - Banks township was enumerated with Waterhead 1841 - From 1841, the constablowick of Banks was enumerated with Burtholme and Waterhead.
Belbank	1951 - Belbank was subsumed within Stapleton CP in 1934
Bewcastle	1871 - Figure for the whole of Bewcastle Parish only from now on. 1981 - 339 persons usually resident. 1991 - 381 persons usually resident.
Brackenhill	1881 - Brackenhill was no longer enumerated separately after 1871. Combined figure for Arthuret Parish only.
Brampton	1871 - Combined figure for Brampton Parish, including the townships of Brampton, Easby & Naworth. 1891 - Population decline appears due to the creation of the new Parish of Midgeholme in 1883 from Midgeholme in Farlam Parish and land from surrounding parishes including the Tindale Fell area of Naworth township in Brampton Parish. Also closure of the Spelter Works in 1895 and a reduction in other industrial activity in the Tindale Fell area of Naworth Township. 1951 - Brampton CP was created in 1934 from Brampton and part of Farlam 1971 - Increase in population due to construction of the test site for the Blue Streak rocket at Spadeadam close to Brampton, with an influx of skilled workers and their families. The project was abandoned in 1973. 1981 - 3686 persons usually resident. 1991 - 3957 persons usually resident.
Brunstock	1881 - Brunstock no longer enumerated separately after 1871. Combined figure for whole of Crosby on Eden Parish only.
Burtholme	1841 - Increase in population may be due to construction of Newcastle-Carlisle railway. Also includes figure for Banks. 1951 - Burtholme CP created in 1934 from Burtholme and part of Waterhead. 1981 - 184 persons usually resident. 1991 - 182 persons usually resident.
Carlton	1861 - Formerly extra-parochial, Carlton, Geltside and Midgeholme were created parishes. 1981 - 44 persons usually resident. 1991 - 39 persons usually resident.
Castle Carrock	1981 - 284 persons usually resident. 1991 - 296 persons usually resident.
Crosby on Eden	1951 - Crosby upon Eden CP abolished in 1934. Part was subsumed within Stanwix CP, part within Wetherall CP
Cumrew	1951 - Cumrew CP created in 1934 from Cumrew and part of Croglin. 1981 - 73 persons usually resident. 1991 - 76 persons usually resident.

Cumwhitton	1871-2001: Combined figure for Cumwhitton parish, including the townships of Cumwhitton, Moorthwaite & Northscaugh 1981 - 293 persons usually resident. 1991 - 321 persons usually resident.
Easby	1871 - From 1871, combined figure for Brampton Parish, including the townships of Brampton, Easby & Naworth.
Etterby	1871 - 'The increase in population is mainly attributed to the operations of a building society' - Stanwix as a whole. 1881 - From 1881, Etterby no longer enumerated separately. Included under Stanwix Parish.
Farlam	1801-61: Combined figure for East and West Farlam. 1861 - Increase in population mainly attributed to the erection of houses for colliers who formerly resided in Brampton. 1951 - Farlam CP created in 1934. Part of Farlam was used to create Brampton CP. 1981- 489 persons usually resident. 1991 - 578 persons usually resident.
Geltsdale Forest	1861 - Formerly extra-parochial, Carlatton, Geltside and Midgeholme were created parishes. 1981 - 0 persons usually resident 1991 - 0 persons usually resident.
Great Corby	1831 - Combined figure for Wetherall and Warwick bridge 1881 - From 1881, combined figure for the whole of Wetherall Parish only.
Hayton	1871-2001: Combined figure for Hayton Parish, including the townships of Hayton and Talkin 1891 - Hayton becomes a subdistrict at this point and covers other parishes. Figures continue to be recorded separately. 1981 - 2208 persons usually resident. 1991 - 2221 persons usually resident.
Hethersgill	1981 - 369 persons usually resident. 1991 - 402 persons usually resident.
Houghton	1891 - From 1891, Houghton no longer enumerated separately. Included under Stanwix Parish.
Irthington	1871-2001: Combined figure for whole parish, including the townships of Irthington, Laversdale, Newby & Newtown. 1981- 639 persons usually resident. 1991 - 691 persons usually resident.
Kingmoor	1981 - 382 persons usually resident. 1991 - 436 persons usually resident.
Kingwater	1901 - Kingwater previously constituted a township of Lanercost Parish. Became a Civil Parish in 1894 1981 - 192 persons usually resident. 1991 - 204 persons usually resident.
Kirkandrews on Es	Figures from 1801 to 1931 represent the population of the entire parish of Kirkandrews on Esk, including Kirkandrews Middle, Kirkandrews Nether, Moat and Nichol Forest. 1851 - Decline in population is attributed to the incorporation of farms and to the removal of cottages. 1881-1901 - Nichol Forest not included. 1951 - Kirkandrews on Esk CP created in 1934 using Moat, Kirkandrews Middle and Kirkandrews Nether.

Talkin	1881-2001: Combined figure for Hayton Parish, including the townships of Hayton and Talkin
Tarraby	1881 - From 1881, Tarraby no longer enumerated separately. Included under Stanwix Parish.
Trough	1951 - Trough subsumed within Solport CP in 1934.
Upper Denton	1921 - Slight increase in population may be attributed to the proximity of the Convalescent Home. 1981 - 115 persons usually resident. 1991 - 115 persons usually resident.
Walby	1881 - Walby no longer enumerated separately after 1871. Combined figure for whole of Crosby on Eden Parish only.
Walton (High & Low	High and Low Walton jointly maintained their poor. 1981 - 283 persons usually resident. 1991 - 275 persons usually resident.
Warwick Bridge	1841 - Combined figure with warwick bridge 1881 - From 1881, combined figure for the whole of Wetheral Parish only.
Waterhead	1841 - Includes figure for Banks. 1921 - Increase in population attributed to the number of staff and patients at the Convalecent Home and to industrial development. 1951 - Waterhead CP created in 1934 using part of Waterhead. The other part of Waterhead was used to create Burtholme CP 1981 - 140 persons usually resident. 1991 - 118 persons usually resident.
