

Skelsmergh: Dodding Green Roman Catholic Priests

- c.1714-1741 Thomas Roydon
(riding-priest on Westmorland circuit from 1699 and as vicar-general for Northern District was always more than a local priest but probably based at Dodding by or before 1714)
- 1741-1764 Thomas Roydon (Jun)
- 1765-1799 Robert Johnson
- 1799-1802 John Lonsdale
- 1802-1812 Robert Bannister
- 1812-1834 Thomas Wilkinson
(assistant to Kendal priest Thomas Johnson from 1793 taking over from him in 1803, looked after both parishes while living at Dodding 1812-1834. Priest for Kendal only 1834-1853 but for much of this time there was no functioning mission at Dodding so the congregations were combined - see below)
- 1834-1838 Henry Rutter
- 1840-1858 Charles Brigham
(installed by hereditary trustee as priest but refused faculties by successive Vicars Apostolic so resident but non-practising)
- 1860-1868 Robert Hogarth
- 1868-1874 Ralph Platt
- 1879-1890 Luke Currey
- 1891-1916 Henry Brettargh
- 1916-1925 Joseph Dunn

(1925 Wilfred Carr appointed but died before taking up residence and parish served from Kendal until 1928)

- 1928-1938 Charles Fleming
- 1938-1943 Richard Kershaw
- 1945-1947 Joseph Tootell
- 1947-1983 Joseph Bamber
- 1984 -1990 William Jackson

1990 Dodding Green ceased to be an independent parish. The Catholic Cenacolo Community has been resident at the site since 2004.
