Churches

- (a) Old church All Saint's, 12th cent. but much altered. Inscription "Thomas Denton, 1697 "; brass to Francis Salkeld, 1711; slab on floor, probably old communion table. Moore chapel, 1862, on site of Salkeld Dormitory (Bp. Nicolson, *Misc. Ace.*, 103).
- (b) New church built, 1897-99.

Pele-towers:

- (a) Whitehall, early tower of Sir. Henry Percy, restored by Lancelot Salkeld, 1589, and enlarged by George. Moore 1861 (Curwen, *Castles*, 405).
- (b) Harby Brow, of Alex. Highmoor 1465, and additions (Curwen, Castles, 371).
