Motte? at Frizington (Curwen, Castles, 39).

Church, now St. Michael's; rebuilt 1829, restored and tower added 1904. Gravestones of ? 11th, 12th and 13th cents. Font of 14th cent. inscribed 1578 (J. H. Martindale, N.S. V, 309).

Old road: Gatra-St. Michael's -Arlecdon-Frizington and towards Egremont (see Dean).

Boundary stone: "Cross Lacon," Rheda; placed as at present c. 1890 (Calverley, Crosses, 256).

Find: Stone hammer, 1857, 300 yds. W. of Kidburn gill.
