BASSENTHWAITE

Church:

- (a) St. Bega's, sometimes called St. Bridget's, 12 cent. foundation; traces of Early Dec. work; almost entirely rebuilt 1874. Two graveslabs of de Highmor, the inscriptions now illegible. Tablet to the Vanes of Armathwaite. Iron stand for pulpit hourglass
- (b) St. John's, built 1878.
- *Beacon* on Skiddaw 1468 (N. and B. i, xliv). R. S. Ferguson said (N.S. xiv, 140) that more than one fire would be needed.
