CROOK

Church, mentioned 1560; St. Catherine's. Nave and tower of c. 1620 (o.s. vi, 204) ; church rebuilt, 1887. Bell 13th cent. (o.s. vi, 85).

Domestic:

Crook Hall of Philipsons, 17th cent. (N. & B. i, 141).

Bridge Gilpin bridge built 1823 (J. F. Curwen, MS.).

Finds:

(a) Stone hammer (*Proc. S.A. N.S.* viii, 491).

(b) Skillet, found before 1876 at Docker (o.s. iii, p. xxv)
