- (b) Stone (C.I.L. vii, 932) now at Carlisle Museum from Newby Grange, originally from Carlisle (F. Haverfield, o.s. xiii, 438).

Barras or Bishop's dyke (see Irthington).

Church, St. John's, anciently St. Mary's, rebuilt 1855. Norman font.

"Cardinal well " on bank of Irthing at Newby
