### CROSBY-ON-EDEN

#### *Roman*

- (a) Wall and Valium explored at Whitemoss near Wallhead;no definite traces of milecastle at Wallhead (F. Haverfield, o.s.xiii, 460-462).
- (b) Stone (C.I.L. vii, 932) now at Carlisle Museum from Newby Grange, originally from Carlisle (F. Haverfield, o.s. xiii, 438).

*Barras or Bishop's dyke (see Irthington) .*

*Church, St. John's, anciently St. Mary's, rebuilt 1855. Norman font.*

"Cardinal well " on bank of Irthing at Newby
