### DRIGG

*Church*, St. Peter's; some Norman and E.E. work, and Trans. arcade of 4 arches, re-used in rebuilding 1850.

*Cross*: Percy Cross, at Hallsenna ; arms of Percy and Furness Abbey.

*Domestic* :

(a) Hall Carleton, lintel, 1695.

(b) Drigg Cross is a house  $\frac{1}{4}$  m. E. of the meeting of bounds of Drigg, Bolton and Seascale (Parker, N.S. ix, 89)

*Spa*, chalybeate,  $\frac{3}{4}$  m. S.S.W. of Drigg station.
