- Hill-fort : Castle head or " Atterpile Castle." Flint implements, human and animal bones, Roman coins and Anglian 9th cent. coins, found 1765 (W. T. Watkin, *Rom. Lancs.* 215; Stockdale, *Ann. Caerm.* 4, 204; N S. i, 316)
- *Cave*, Merlewood; bones, Roman pottery, 9th cent. Anglian coins found (H. S. Cowper, o.s. xii, 277).
- [Church: St. Paul's, consecrated 1853. Bell of 1772 from Cartmel.]

Domestic

- (a) Ancient house of Carters or guides over Sands, at Carter Lane
- (b) Ancient house, Cart Lane, now modernized (Mr. Isaac Wilson).

Find : Roman coin of Philip, Cart Lane.
