

Ancient Monuments in this township

1923 List

GRINSDALE

Earthworks : two square enclosures with mounds before each of their four entrances (R. S. Ferguson, *Arch. Survey*)

Roman: Wall; last pieces above ground destroyed c. 1840 to straighten the path near Grinsdale (Whellan, 168) .

Church: St. Kentigern's, restored 1740, 1896. Embankment to churchyard built before 1703 (Bishop Nicolson, *Miscell. Acc.* 13) .

Old road: Grinsdale church - Kirksteads-Little Orton - Old Carlisle (O.S. iv, 323).

Find: Gold necklace, 2nd cent A.D., found 1860 on the line of the Wall (British Museum; reproduction at Carlisle Museum).
