IREBY

Tumulus: Binsey (J. C. Ward, O.S. iii, 245).

Church:

- (a) Old church, 1¼ m. W. of Low Ireby; restored 1880.
- (b) New church, St. James', built 1846; two graveslabs, piscina and font from the old church.

Finds

- (a) Stone hammer, 1878, ½ m. S. of new church.
- (b) Stone implement, 1870, ⅓ m. S. of new church.
- (c) Roman antiquities, ½ m. S.W. of new church.
