HINCASTER

[*Mounds* at Hincaster, thought by West (*Guide*, 116) to be Roman, are natural (o.s. xiii, 56).]

Chapel

(a) founded 1190; in 1675 called " Grove chapel " (Ogilby's map) ; rebuilt 1773 (N. & B. i, 210) and enlarged 1842.

(b) St. Thomas' built 1875 on a new site (o.s. xiii, 55).

Canal, begun 1792 (J. F. Curwen, N.S. xvii, 26).

Finds:flints , at Hincaster (o.s. vi, 201).
