BURTON AND HOLME

Romano-British ? The Quamps, foundations and millstones (Hodgson, *Westmd.* 230; *Gent. Mag. Lib., Rom. Brit.*, ii, 344, quoted by Ferguson, *Survey*).

Churches:

(a) Burton, mentioned 1120-30 (Farrer, *Kendale ii*, 142). Late pre-Norman cross-head, shaft and two fragments (W.G.C. in Calverley, *Crosses*, 89). Two piscinae (o.s. xii, 210). Old font. Preston chapel, ? 1634; Dalton chapel, ? 1636. Church altered 1844, restored 1872 (J. Chalmers, o.s. xiii, 64). St. Helen's well (N. & B. i, 235).

(b) Holme, Holy Trinity, 1839

Canal, see PRESTON PATRICK.

Old road:

(a) from Over Kellet by Tewetfield and the Buckstone (J. F. Curwen).

(b) Turnpike road Kendal to Kirkby Lonsdale made shortly before 1775 (N. & B. i, 9).

Finds:

(a) stone implements, Clawthorpe (*Lonsd. Mag.* i, 291, quoted by Ferguson, *Survey*).

(b) Stone celt, c. 1888, between Overthwaite and Holme (N.s. iii, 41I)
