HUGILL (INGS)

" *Brit. Sett.* " ramparts and hut-circles, ¼m. N. of High House (o.s.,vi, 86; xii, 6; xiv, 46o).

Roman road, track ? Staveley-Broadgate (o.s. vi, 86).

Church,

(a) St. Anne's, built 1743, enlarged 1878, restored 1899. Three bells of 1734 (o.s. vi, 85).
Marble floor (o.s. iv, 77).

(b) Site of ancient chapel of St. Anne at Grassgarth (N. & B. i, 141; N.S. viii, 134; xiii, 81).

Domestic : Highhouse of Braithwaites, 17th cent.; arms in window (o.s. vi, 106, 203; viii, 134)
