## **KIRKBAMPTON**

## Roman:

- (a) altar to Latis from Foldsteads now at Carlisle Museum (C.I.L. vii, 938; H. D. Rawnsley, N.S. xx, 151).
- (b) Stone found 1870-71 at the church (C.I.L. vii, 942).
- Earthwork: "Foldsteads"; double rampart and double ditch; the remaining corner rounded (Canon J. Wilson, N.S. ii, 413).
- *Church:* St. Peter's, late 12th cent., with Roman stones used; rude tympanum and caps. to chancel-arch; restored 1870-71 1882; 12th cent. window reinserted in new gable c. 1890. Lowside window (J. H. Martindale, *N.s.* xiii, 252). Graveslab. Bell 1705.

## Wells:

- (a)" Yeddle well," 100 yds. N.N.W. of Rectory.
- (b)" Toddel well," chalybeate, W. of Toddel hill.
