KIRKBAMPTON

Roman :

(a) altar to Latis from Foldsteads now at Carlisle Museum (C.I.L. vii, 938; H. D. Rawnsley, N.S. xx, 151).

(b) Stone found 1870-71 at the church (C.I.L. vii, 942).

Earthwork : " Foldsteads "; double rampart and double ditch; the remaining corner rounded (Canon J. Wilson, N.S. ii, 413).

Church: St. Peter's, late 12th cent., with Roman stones used; rude tympanum and caps. to chancel-arch; restored 1870-71 1882 ; 12th cent. window reinserted in new gable c. 1890. Lowside window (J. H. Martindale, N.s. xiii, 252). Graveslab. Bell 1705.

Wells:

(a)" Yeddle well," 100 yds. N.N.W. of Rectory.

(b)" Toddell well," chalybeate, W. of Toddell hill.
