

## Ancient Monuments in this township

### 1923 List

#### KIRKLINTON

*Site of Motte:* " Castle hill," ½ m. N. of church; ? seat of de Levingtons (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. x, 107).

*Church:* St. Cuthbert's; Roman and Norman stones, rebuilt 1845. Five graveslabs.

*Stonehouse :*

- (a) Highgate in Hethersgill, of Taylors, 1600 (Curwen, *Castles*, 410) .
- (b) Kirklington Hall, of the Dacres.

*Old roads:* " Waingate head," ¾ m. E. of Brackenhill.

*Sites:*

- (a) (?) "Standingstone rigg" 1¾ m. S. of church.
- (b) (?) " Crossbank hill," ¼ m. S. of Bolton fell end.
