KIRKLINTON

Site of Motte: "Castle hill," ½ m. N. of church; ? seat of de Levingtons (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. x, 107).

Church: St. Cuthbert's; Roman and Norman stones, rebuilt 1845. Five graveslabs.

Stonehouse:

- (a) Highgate in Hethersgill, of Taylors, 1600 (Curwen, Castles, 410).
- (b) Kirklinton Hall, of the Dacres.

Old roads: "Waingate head," 3/4 m. E. of Brackenhill.

Sites:

- (a) (?)"Standingstone rigg" 1¾ m. S. of church.
- (b) (?) " Crossbank hill," ¼ m. S. of Bolton fell end.
