1923 List

MELMERBY

Earthwork : between Cunsfell and Melmerby High Scar (J. G. Goodchild, O.S. vi, 488) .

Roman: The Maiden Way.

Church:

(a) St. John Baptist's; remains of 14th cent., restored 1849 and 1895. Graveslabs, sword with the maunch of Threlkeld, late 13th cent; book and shears of ? Robt. de Bromfield, rector, 1353; and a third, perhaps de Melmerby (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. xx, 45).

(b) St. John the Baptist's well.

Domestic: Melmerby Hall, ? 1658, of the Threlkelds, and later of Pattensons (W. Jackson, O.S. x, i; T. H. B. Graham, N.S. xvii, 23).

Site of Gale Hall, of Huttons, and later of Holmes (N.S. xvii, 25).

Finds : Coffin-chalice and paten, found 1881 in the churchyard, now in Penrith Museum (Dr. H. Barnes, N.S. vii, 32).
