OLD AND NEW HUTTON

Churches:

(a) Old Hutton, now St. John Baptist's, 1873, replacing chapel built before 1621 (Farrer, *Kendale i*, 196), rebuilt 1699 (N. & B. i, 108) .

(b) New Hutton, now St. Stephen's, 1878, replacing chapel of 1739 (N. & B. i, 108).

Domestic: Bleaze Hall (M. W. Taylor, *Manorial Halls*, 229).

Roads: Kendal to Sedbergh and to Kirkby Lonsdale, see KENDAL.

Find: Stone axe-hammer, before 1904, at Old Hutton (N.s. vii,64).
