NICHOL FOREST

*Ancient Chapel site:*

- (a) 200 yds. N.E. of present church (which was built 1866).
- (b) Another ancient chapel stood on N. side of Chapel Hill, E. of Catlowdy:  
at Catlowdy is the " Priest's well."

*Tower:*

- (a) Stonehaugh, ruins, 40 by 24 ft., walls 4½ft. thick (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. ix, 216; Curwen, *Castles*, 397).
- (b) Stonegarthside Hall, old house of the Forsters  
(T. H. B. Graham, N.S. ix, 217).

*Old road (?)*:

- (a) At Stonygate, ¼m. N.N.E. of the church.
