## Earthworks:

- (a) "Crewgarth" double rampart; plan pentagonal. Urn and masonry found before 1860; masonry, a quern?, a mortar and celt found 1884 (Whellan, 584; O.S. viii, 66).
- (b) "Fort," 1/2 m. E.N.E. of Townhead on Ardale beck (Ordnance map) .

*Church:* St. Patrick's or St. Luke's, part 13th cent.; restored c.1855.Oaken effigy, 13th cent. (R. S. Ferguson, O.S. viii, 65)
