OUSBY

Tumulus ? " Meg's cairn " on Maiden Way, N.E. of Cunsfell.

Roman: The Maiden Way.

Earthworks:

(a) "Crewgarth" double rampart; plan pentagonal. Urn and masonry found before 1860 ; masonry, a quern ?, a mortar and celt found 1884 (Whellan, 584; O.S. viii, 66).

(b) " Fort," ½ m. E.N.E. of Townhead on Ardale beck (Ordnance map) .

Church: St. Patrick's or St. Luke's, part 13th cent.; restored c.1855.Oaken effigy, 13th cent. (R. S. Ferguson, O.S. viii, 65)
