### PATTERDALE AND HARTSOP

*Cairns* on Hartsop beck, W. of leadmine (o.s. iii, 253).

*Roman road*, " High Street," from the Knott over High Street.

*Chapel* mentioned 1581 (N. & B. i, 404). Church, St. Patrick's, built 1853. Font, 13th cent. base and bowl. Ancient Yew. St.Patrick's well.

#### *Domestic:*

(a) Hartsop Hall (N. & B. i, 408).

(b) Patterdale Hall (*ibid.* 409).

#### *Old mines :*

(a) Mirehead, S. of Hartsop mill. W. of Hartsop Hall.

(b) Eagle Crag, S. of Striding edge.

(c) Brown Cove, N. of Swirrel edge.

(d) Lead mines opened *c.* 1755 (Clarke, *Survey*, 33). Greenside mines in Glenridding opened late 18th cent. (J. Postlethwaite,

*Mines and Mining in Lake District*, 123). Hartsop quarry working in 1785 (Clarke, *Survey*, 154)

*Old roads* :Kirkstone pass mentioned 13th cent. (N. s. xviii, 151)
