Cairns on Hartsop beck, W. of leadmine (o.s. iii, 253).

Roman road, "High Street," from the Knott over High Street.

Chapel mentioned 1581 (N. & B. i, 404). Church, St. Patrick's, built 1853. Font, 13th cent. base and bowl. Ancient Yew. St.Patrick's well.
