## PRESTON PATRICK AND PRESTON RICHARD

[Premonstratensian priory founded here c. 1191 and removed to Shap, 1199]

*Church: Chapel* of St. Gregory *c.* 1400 (Farrer, *Kendale ii*, 208, see also 298), rebuilt *temp*. Henry VII and 1852; chancel rebuilt 1892. Piscina (o.s. xii, 21I). Gregory well.

Tower: Preston Patrick Hall; twin towers 15th? cent.; house remodelled c. 1625 (Rev. B. Barnett, o.s. xiii, 56; Curwen, Castles, 390)

## Domestic:

- (a) Challon, formerly Chanon Hall, of Wakefields, 1594, rebuilt 1770 (o.s. xiii, 57).
- (b) Quaker "Sepulchre," Birkrigg park (N. & B. i, 213).

Canal, begun 1792 (J. F. Curwen, N.S. xvii, 26).

Roads: Tatebeck [wooden foot-]bridge decayed 1681, replaced by a stone bridge (Q. Sess. Records).
