PRESTON PATRICK AND PRESTON RICHARD

[Premonstratensian priory founded here *c.* 1191 and removed to Shap, 1199]

Church: Chapel of St. Gregory *c.* 1400 (Farrer, *Kendale ii*, 208, see also 298), rebuilt *temp.* Henry VII and 1852; chancel rebuilt 1892. Piscina (o.s. xii, 21I). Gregory well.

Tower :Preston Patrick Hall; twin towers 15th ? cent.; house remodelled *c.* 1625 (Rev. B. Barnett, o.s. xiii, 56; Curwen, *Castles*, 390)

Domestic:

(a) Challon, formerly Chanon Hall, of Wakefields, 1594, rebuilt 1770 (o.s. xiii, 57).

(b) Quaker " Sepulchre," Birkrigg park (N. & B. i, 213).

Canal, begun 1792 (J. F. Curwen, N.S. xvii, 26).

Roads:Tatebeck [wooden foot-]bridge decayed 1681, replaced by a stone bridge (*Q. Sess. Records*).
