SATTERTHWAITE

Church,

- (a) All Saints', Chapel mentioned 1650; rebuilt 1835. Oak chest c. 1578 (N.s. xiv, 309). Bell, 1737 (F. C. Cheetham, *Trans. Lane. and C. Soc.*, xl).
- (b) Chapel at Graythwaite in 17th cent. ; site unknown (H. S. Cowper, *Hawkshead*, III),

Domestic:

- (a) Graythwaite Low Hall, of Sawreys *temp.* Henry VIII, and then of Rawlinsons. The house 17th ? cent. (*ibid.*, 163).
- (b) Graythwaite (High) Hall of Sandys since 15th cent., modernized. Armorial stone of ? 1578. Collection of portraits; panelling from
- (c) ? Tytup Hall (*ibid.*, 162).

Bloomeries:

- (a) Farragrain bridge; Low Dale park; below Fir Island;
- (b) Force forge; Cunsey mill (o.s. xv, 221, 222).
- (c) Cunsey forge before 1653 (N. & B. i, 191)

Find : Quern, c. 1830, Graythwaite Fieldhead moss (Richardson, *Furness*, i,106).
