### SEBERGHAM

*Earthworks* above Warnell Hall, ? 17th cent. mining (O.S. iii, 305).

*Church*, St. Mary's, originally hermitage and chantry chapel temp. Henry II, made into a church c. 1270 (T. H. B. Graham, N.S. xxiii, 52). Tower built 1825-6; restorations 1880, 1905. Monument to Denton c. 1616 (N.S. xvi, 49); to Relph the poet, d. 1743, monument erected 1794 (R. S. Ferguson, O.S. vii, 253).

*Domestic* :

- (a) Bellbridge, 1688, and additions (J. H. Martindale, N.S. xx, 236).
- (b) Warnell Hall, of Dacres and Dentons, enlarged temp. Eliz. and Charles II (J. H. Martindale, N.S. XX, 238)
