THRELKELD

Hut-circles and enclosures : Threlkeld Knott, explored 1901; querns found (C. W. Dymond and T. H. Hodgson, N.S. ii, 38).

Church, St. Mary's, rebuilt 1777. Bells, treble c. 1400; tenor pre-Reformation ? Brass to Irtons 1650.

Old Hall: of Threlkelds, site 200 yds. S. E. of Threlkeld Hall.

Old road : Threlkeld to Applethwaite 1220-21 (*Fountains Chartulary*) .

Old mines : Gategill, worked before gunpowder was used, *i.e.* 17th cent, Saddleback, Bleasgill, Glenderaterra (J. Postlethwaite, *Mines, etc.*, 96).

Find: Stone "quoit " from Threlkeld pasture in Mrs. Gillbanks' collection, Clifton, Penrith (N.S. iii, 407)
