THURSBY

Roman : line of the road, Nealhouse to "Waspatrick wath" *i.e.* ford of Wampool, was in use 1217 (N.S. v, 44) and 1300 (Perambulation of Inglewood)

Church: St. Andrew's, rebuilt 1846. Six bells 1846, framed in oak of old church. Brisco monuments from 1741. Thomlinson tablet, 1802.
