### WHICHAM

*Church*, St. Mary's; S. door 12th cent. New windows and, transept, 1858; restoration 1901  
(Rev. W. S. Sykes, N.S. ii, 322).

*Beacon* on Black Combe 1468 (N. and B. i, xliv).

*Bloomery*, S.W. of Knot end, at Grice Croft Close (Rev. W.S. Sykes)

*Old roads:*

(a) " High Street "

(b) Gateside, Cross bank, Chappels and Lanthwaite bridge.

*Finds :*

(a) Stone hammer, Arrow hill, 1860

(b) Stone hammer, S. of Silecroft, 1862 (O.S. i, 280).

(d) Stone celt, 4m. W. of S. from Bason bank (J. Cooper, N.S. xviii, 105)
