

Ancient Monuments in this township

1923 List

WHITBECK

Stone circles:

- (a) Annaside, $\frac{2}{3}$ m N.N.W. of Gutterby; one stone remaining.
- (b) " Kirkstones," site of double circle and cairn, 300 yds. S.E. of Gutterby (O.S. i, 28o) .
- (c) Site of Standing stones, $\frac{1}{4}$ m. W. of Hall force.

Earthwork: " Cockpit," $\frac{1}{4}$ m. N. of Monkfoss, explored 1899 ; ?fishponds of site given to Furness Abbey 1127 (O.S. xvi, 117).

Church, now St. Mary's, restored 1883. E.E. font. Effigy of " the Lady of Annaside," c. 1300. Cuir-bouilli chalice case, c.1500 (O.S. vii, 76) . Hospital, built c. 1630-39.

Spa below highwater mark off Gutterby.

Bloomery, " Cinder hill," N.W. of the church.

Old road, " High street," as in Bootle.
